

Systemd - Start my own script at boot on Ubuntu Server 18.04

- `sudo su`
- `cd /lib/systemd/system/`
- `vi /lib/systemd/system/politick.service`

politick.service

```
[Unit]

Description="Loads iptables and setup DNS with our new dynamic IP"
After=network.target

Before=bind9.service

[Service]
ExecStart=/home/politick/PolitickStartup.sh

[Install]
WantedBy=multi-user.target
```

- `chmod 766 politick.service`
- `cd /etc/systemd/system/multi-user.target.wants/`
- `ln -s /lib/systemd/system/politick.service /etc/systemd/system/multi-user.target.wants/politick.service`
- `systemctl enable politick.service`

- `cd ~politick`
- `vi /home/politick/PolitickStartup.sh`
